Corinna Gosmaro (Savigliano, 1987). Her work focuses on reflexions about the human being as a global entity and his/her timeless characteristics. The practice is based on the expression of a cognitive and psycho-physical process activated through the interaction with the environment. Going back and forth on the border between painting and sculpture, the work draws this journey throughout the history of our culture. The possibility of engaging different patterns elucidating the distinction between the work and

its display represents another—step further in her work.
